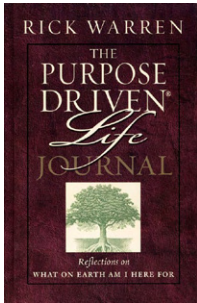

- We were made for a mission, so your fifth purpose is to live out real evangelism.

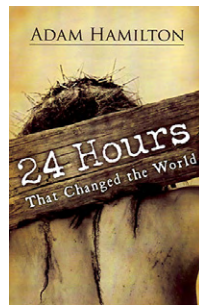
ROMANS STUDY

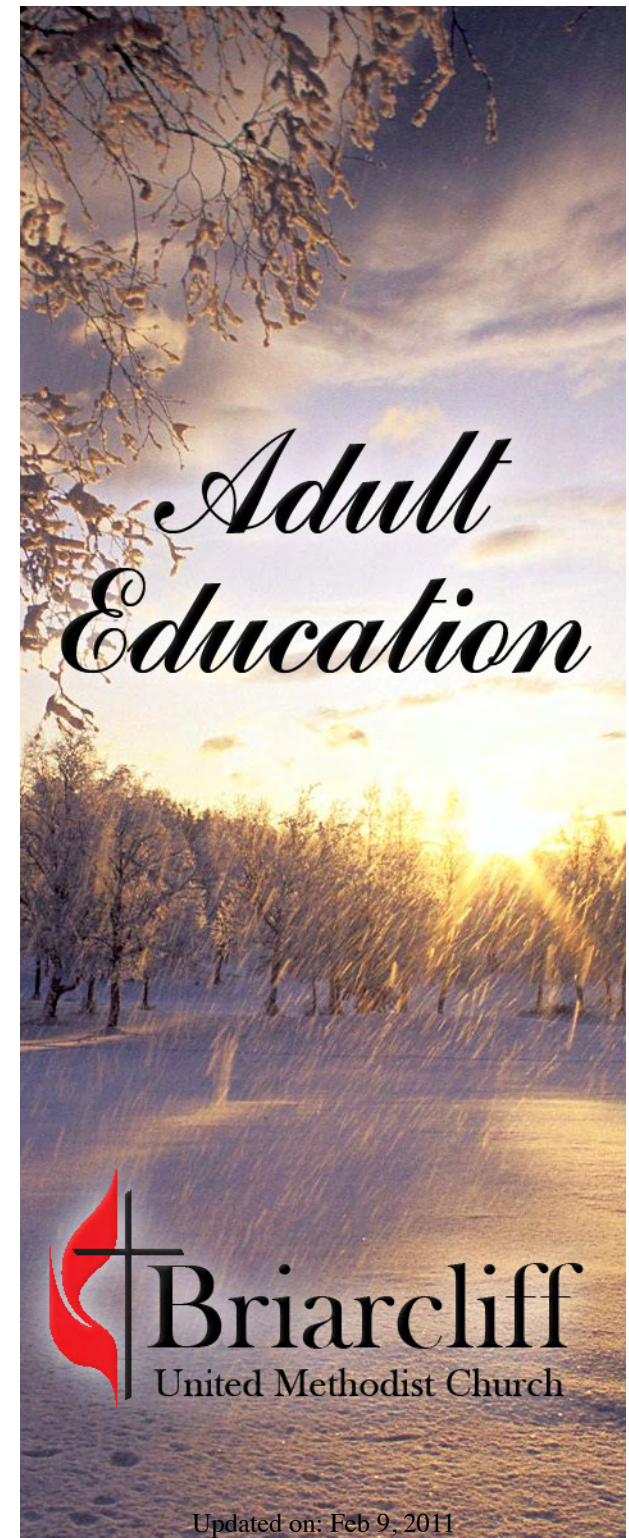

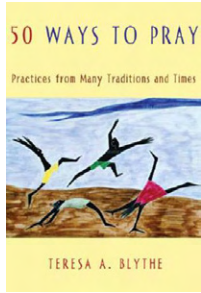

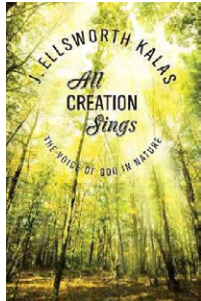
LIVING IN PRAYER

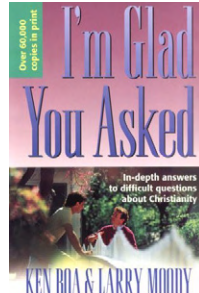
KOINONIA CLASS
